The mushroom shape of this large storage jar results from the use of a deep dish form used to hold and shape the base of the pot. Acomita Polychrome was made in various shapes between 1770 and 1880. Typical are the flowing geometric decorations seen on this jar, as are the triangles decorating the neck and red-slipped underbody.
